This LPG Summit, being held on Wednesday 7th April, will be open to all, and will be of particular interest to LPG stakeholders, including East African Ministers responsible for Petroleum Energy, Health, Environment, Trade, Industry, as well as the related regulatory agencies, national standard bodies, consumer organizations, LPG value chain players, non-governmental organizations (NGO's) and financial/funding institutions.

The Summit will take the form of a virtual event with remote contributions. It will include topics that focus on the unique *life support* attributes that LPG as a cooking fuel brought out during the COVID-19 pandemic. LPG proved to be reliable, resilient, and essential, as it continued to successfully transition people away from harmful traditional cooking fuels, such as wood and charcoal during the pandemic. Across the whole of East Africa and beyond, LPG proved to be a reliable, resilient, and essential cooking fuel, even during lockdowns and recessions.

SUMMIT: The Summit will take the form of two parts. The morning session will include speakers from across the African continent. The afternoon session will include international speakers. Delegates who register for the Summit can participate in both sessions. The day will include a session on Women in LPG (WINLPG) and the launch of a National WINLPG Chapter in East Africa.

In line with the theme, **LPG: A Reliable, Resilient and Essential cooking fuel**, the Summit will include:

- a) A review of the global and African LPG business, and assess the latest supply, demand and pricing dynamics
- b) The outcome of studies that have verified the link between cooking fuels, improved health, and the burden of preventable illness
- c) A discussion on the importance of health in economic development
- d) A discussion about how LPG has become essential in preserving our planet
- e) An assessment of the impact of clean cooking on the United Nation's Sustainable Development Goals
- f) An assessment of managing COVID-19 risk for persons that are exposed to smoke from cooking fuels
- g) A discussion about the important roles that the health, environment, agriculture, manufacturing, gender equality, education and energy sectors need to jointly undertake to achieve LPG penetration targets

- h) A discussion about the importance of educating communities, and especially women, on the benefits of using LPG
- i) An assessment of the role that the Internet of Things has on easing access to LPG and improving safety and efficiency and contributing to business improvement
- j) An assessment on the last mile delivery innovations and the impact in increasing LPG penetration
- k) An assessment how other markets have sustainably developed their LPG sector and the importance of LPG for power generation
- l) A discussion on how the coronavirus pandemic has impacted the operations of LPG business in East Africa, Africa, and beyond
